5. Executive Summary

This delegated decision will approve and allocate residual funding from the Transforming Cities Fund Devolved Pot to the Northumberland County Council, Ponteland to Callerton Cycleway Phase 2 scheme following successful appraisal in accordance with the Transport Assurance Framework.

Delegated authority was sought from the Joint Transport Committee for the Transport North East Managing Director, in consultation with the Section 73 Officer and Monitoring Officer, subject to successful appraisal of the scheme Business Case and due diligence in line with the Transport Assurance Framework, to approve the scheme and enter into a Grant Funding Agreement with Northumberland County Council. Appraisal concluded successfully in August 2023 as such this decision will approve £518,000 of Transforming Cities Fund grant funds for the Ponteland to Callerton Cycleway Phase 2 scheme.
